

Art and Design

Oak will be studying wildlife and how to capture small details through using different media. They will create observational drawings, printings, textured clay tiles and 3D models.

Computing

Pupils will learn about computer systems and networks by exploring different systems and searches online.

Design and Technology

This term we will be experimenting with food by creating a World War II inspired soup, using our knowledge of rationing and food seasonality.

English - Reading

As a class we will be reading 'Letters from the Lighthouse', which will give us an insight into the lives of evacuees during World War II. Children will make inferences, predictions, explanations and summaries around the the text.

English – Writing

Using their reading text as inspiration, pupils will write character and setting descriptions, newspaper reports and book reviews. They will start to use Year 5 grammatical techniques to improve their writing.



Curriculum Information for parents/carers

Year 5 – Oak – Autumn 1

In Year 5, we aim to develop the children's independence and responsibilities. They will see the positive relationship a good attitude to learning has on their achievements.

Geography

We will develop our map reading skills through studying Ordnance Survey maps of our local area and the world. We will use grid references and route plans.

History

We will study the significance of the railways during WWII. We will develop our knowledge of the evolution of railways over time.

Maths

Place Value to 1,000,000, Addition and Subtraction of numbers to 1,000,000 and formal written methods of Multiplication and Division.

Modern Foreign Languages

Oak will learn how to introduce and tell peers about themselves in French. Children will learn to ask and answer questions around their appearance, actions and feelings.

Music

Pupils listen, sing, play, improvise and compose music based on 'Livin' on a Prayer'.

We will explore the relationships with people around us, through regulating our own emotions and understand those of our peers'.
